


# How To Write A Blog Comment

- 1 Click on the blog **post title** or the '**comment**' link at the top or at the bottom of the post.
- 2 Scroll down the page to the **comment form** or click on **Reply** (to reply to a specific comment).
- 3 Enter your **name** and **email address** (your email address is hidden and only the blogger sees it). If you are logged in to your Edublogs account you won't need to add these details.
- 4 Write your **comment**. Then enter the **anti-spam word**.

- 5 Select 'Notify me of followup comments via e-mail' if you want to be notified of comments by other readers.
